APPROVE MINUTES

M. Swaer moved to approve the minutes from the April 5, 2017 SORAB meeting. M. Erickson seconded the motion. **The motion carried unanimously.**

RESIDENCY APPEAL FROM DANIEL J. STEENO

D. Adler read the opening statement. M. Swaer brought to the board's attention the fact that Mr. Steeno is requesting to live at 2546 Shawano Ave., but the Department of Corrections has another offender listed as residing at that address. The village's sex offender density ordinance prohibits more than one sex offender living in the same dwelling, even if there are separate apartments in it.

L.A. Wagner Kroening reviewed the status of previously approved offenders and could not find another approved offender still residing at 2546 Shawano Ave.

M. Swaer moved to table the residency appeal from Daniel J. Steeno, in order to allow time for the Howard Police Department to follow up on the status of the offender listed at the address. D. Boyer seconded. **The motion to table carried unanimously.**

The board will re-convene at 6:30 p.m. on June 28 to consider Mr. Steeno's appeal.
