- WHEREAS,** Deputy Greg Gleason is a 22-year veteran officer with the Brown County Sheriff's Department who serves as a Directed Enforcement Officer with the Village of Howard; and
- WHEREAS,** it is fitting and proper to acknowledge the work ethic and accomplishments of Deputy Gleason for his service to the Village of Howard through the Brown County Sheriff's Department; and
- WHEREAS,** between Oct. 2, 2011 and Oct. 1, 2012, Deputy Gleason made 49 arrests of people charged with operating while intoxicated; and
- WHEREAS,** Deputy Gleason was presented the 2012 Wayne Truttman Award by Sheriff John Gossage for having the highest number of OWI arrests in Brown County for that period; and
- WHEREAS,** between Oct. 2, 2012 and Oct. 1, 2013, Deputy Gleason made 72 arrests of people charged with operating while intoxicated; and
- WHEREAS,** Deputy Gleason was presented the 2013 Wayne Truttman Award by Sheriff John Gossage for having the highest number of OWI arrests in Brown County for that period; and
- WHEREAS,** the village is extremely proud and appreciative of Deputy Gleason's dedication to the safety and well-being of Howard residents and the general public, as well as his achievement in receiving the Wayne Truttman Award for two consecutive years;
