ACTION REQUESTED: Ordinance Resolution Motion Receive/File

POLICY ISSUE

Should the Village Board approve the submitted list of nominations for election officials for the years 2014-2015?

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

State statutes 7.30 details the process for appointing election officials. To summarize this lengthy section of the law, each of the two predominant political parties has the right to nominate election officials and must submit a list by November 30 of each odd numbered year. Any shortfall in number of election officials can be filled by nominations from the village president. The political parties are not required to submit of list of nominations but can do so if they choose.

The Democratic Party submitted 23 names (three of these individuals from the list resigned from election work in past years and were removed from the list), and the Republican Party submitted 12 names. The village uses many more workers for elections with expected large turnouts (US President, Wisconsin Governor and recalls) so the village president is submitting 52 additional names for nomination.

PREVIOUS ACTION

The village board approved the 2012-2013 nomination lists of election officials on December 12, 2011. This approval was the first time in recent memory when the two political parties nominated election workers.
