

## ORDINANCE 2013-13

### AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND RECRATING SECTION 2-502 SETTING COMPENSATION FOR THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND MUNICIPAL JUDGE AND SECTION 2-504 REGARDING EMPLOYEE EXPENSES

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF HOWARD, BROWN COUNTY, WISCONSIN, HEREBY ORDAINS THAT SECTION 2-502 AND 2-504 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF HOWARD, BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS

#### **SECTION 1. Sec. 2-502. Salaries and Compensation of Elected Officials**

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Howard shall establish salaries and compensation for elected officials from time to time. Such salaries shall not be increased during their term of office, except for the municipal judge in accordance with state statutes, but become effective following a local election for said officials. The Board of Trustees of the Village of Howard do hereby ordain the following salaries for elected officials:

- a. Effective immediately following the April 2014 spring elections, the village president shall be compensated an annual salary of \$12,050. Such salary shall be paid in May 2014 on a monthly basis on the fourth Monday of each month, at a rate of \$1,004.17.
- b. Effective immediately following the April 2014 spring elections, the village trustees shall be compensated an annual salary of \$6,025 to be paid on a monthly basis of \$502.83 on the fourth Monday of each month, beginning in May 2014.
- c. Effective January 1, 2014, the municipal judge shall be compensated an annual salary of \$15,750 to be paid on a monthly basis of \$1,312.50 on the fourth Monday of each month.

#### **SECTION 2. Sec. 2-504. Officers' and employees' expenses**

All village officials, when required by their duties to leave the village for training or business affairs of the village, shall be reimbursed for their actual expenses in accordance with section 10 of the personnel policies of the village.

**SECTION 3.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publication.
