4th Annual Miles for Smiles Family Fun Event
May 11th, 2013
Benefiting Riah's Rainbow

Purpose of Event

To raise funds to support Riah's Rainbow, a IRS registered non-profit 501 (c)(3) organization, committed to bringing the creative world to children in hospitals across the United States by providing coloring books, crayons, paints, markers, crafts, etc.; raising awareness for Diffuse Intrinsic Pontine Glioma, and funding research for a cure.

Number of People Attending

Our ultimate goal would be to have 300-325 registered attendees. This number would also include volunteers for the event.

Area of Use

The area in which Riah's Rainbow would like to hold the 4th Annual Miles for Smiles Family Fun Event is Meadowbrook Park Pavilion for registration and information on our organization, part of trail for the run/walk, surrounding grassy areas for bounce house set up, tent set up for children's activities, the playground equipment (next to the pavilion) for our younger guests to enjoy, and an area that can be used for entertainment (DJ set up for the Emcee). We would also need an area, which would be determined by the VOH, for a horse petting area.

The Run/Walk starting line will be the entrance of the parking lot near the baseball diamond by the Meadowbrook Pavilion. The finish line will be the entrance to the 2nd parking lot near the detention pond. We will also have 2 water stations set up on the course with a nurse to ensure participants' safety.

The course for the Run/Walk is included with this application.

Parking lot near baseball diamond, cross Hillcrest - Appollo, Right on Moon Dr, Left on Liberty Bell, Left on Vanguard Way, Right on Early Bird Lane, Left on AerostarDr, Right on Shawano Ave, Right on S Pinecrest Rd, Right on Windover Rd, Left on Molly Brown Lane, Left on Liberty Bell Rd, Left on S. Pinecrest Rd, Left on Atlantas Dr, Right on Windover Rd, Right on Molly Brown Lane, Right on Vanguard Way, cross Hillcrest back to pavilion.

Clean Up Plan & Garbage Removal

The volunteers and board members of Riah's Rainbow will clean up the area in which the event will take place; the trails, the pavilion, the grassy areas, etc. We will bring our own trash bags and bring those trash bags back home with us at the end of the day. The area will be as clean as when we entered the premises on the day of set up.

Crowd Control Plan

The plan is to have open registration from 7:30-8:45 am and then have the Run/Walk start at 9:15 am. People who have already pre-registered shouldn't get there until closer to the time the event starts and all they would need to do is come into the pavilion, tell us their name and pick up their t-shirt. Walk-in registrants will have a longer time in the pavilion due to filling out a registration sheet, handing over money and possibly getting a t-shirt. All registrants will then have enough room outside before the event starts to socialize. Most of the crowd will be in the pavilion or lining up for the start of the Run/Walk.

We will contact the public safety department, Ed Janke, and comply with rules/laws that need to be governed in regards to safety on public streets.

We will also have volunteers all over the area to direct participants to ensure their safety as well.

Parking

Parking for this event shouldn't be an issue. There are plenty of parking spaces by the pavilion area and also at the southwest end of the park. If there is an overflow there are side streets near the park that participants can park and walk if needed to the event.

Portable Toilets

There will be no portable toilets for use by the participants of this event. The bathroom in the pavilion will be adequate.

Impact of Turf/Weather Conditions & Restoration

Riah's Rainbow, Inc. will solely be responsible for any damage it causes on the day of the event.

Services Provided at the Event

The 4th Annual Miles for Smiles Family Fun Event has planned to have many activities:

- Coffee & Bagels available before the event.
- Pre-registered walkers will receive a free t-shirt the day of the event. A registration table will be set up in the pavilion for walk-in registrants.
- There will be a 2.5 mile Walk. Along the course (in the park) we will have ground posters of childhood cancer facts. Attached to each poster will be balloons.
- There will be a 3 mile Run (course description included). There will be signs on every corner as well as traffic controllers to ensure safety.
- Children's area to include: Bounce house, face painting, craft station, Miller & Mike and kid's games.
- Awareness Table with items to purchase: bracelets, t-shirts, tote bags, etc. inside the pavilion.
- Bucket Raffle inside the pavilion.
- We plan to have food & beverages available after the event in the open area attached to the pavilion:
 - Hot Dogs, Fruit, Cheese Sticks, Bananas, Chips, Water/Juice
- We will have an MC to get the event off to a great start. They will introduce our family to talk about why this event is so important to the kids in Northeast Wisconsin. There will also be a song sung just before the participants set off on their run/walk.
- We will have soft music playing when the participants return from their run/walk.

Services Requested from VOH

The services that the 4th Annual Miles for Smiles Family Fun Event would request from Village of Howard would be:

- Outside electricity for the bounce house, Nescos and entertainment.
- Due to the event being early in the season, May 11th, 2013, we would request that the banquet tables be pulled from storage and set up.
- Outside water for the Booyah Kettle.
- Access to the brooms and dust pans in maintenance closet.
- More picnic tables on the grassy area.
