2myles4autism

(A 2-Mile Run/Walk to Raise Autism Awareness)



The 3rd graders in Mrs. Moran's classroom at Meadowbrook Elementary School are in the midst of organizing a 2 mile run/walk at Meadowbrook Park in Howard on April 28th, set to begin at 9:00 a.m. The event has been aptly named 2Myles4Autism, after a young man named Myles in our classroom. April is Autism Awareness Month and the date of the event also happens to be Myle's 9th birthday. Myles is a caring, funny, smart, hard-working student - a student with autism. Autism is a complex developmental disability that typically appears during the first three years of life. It manifests as a combination of developmental challenges such as delays in language, social interaction and play. Autism has been estimated to occur in as many as 1 in 110 children according to the Center for Disease Control. Autism is four times more prevalent in boys than girls and knows no racial, ethnic or social boundaries, and has no cure.

2Myles4Autism was created to build awareness about autism in the Howard-Suamico area and to generate dollars that will directly benefit students in the Howard-Suamico School District. The students in Mrs. Moran's classroom want to help others understand what autism is like and encourage others to be accepting of the differences that make us special and unique.

The Green Bay Packers have already joined us in our efforts as one of our major sponsors and we hope that some of the players or staff will be able to join us for the run. Magician Jim Lenz, international entertainer, will also be performing strolling magic for the participants before and after the event.
