Approve Resolution 2013-24, renaming Dousman Street/Anamax Road/ Elmhurst Avenue to Duck Creek Parkway

RECOMMENDATION:
At its July meeting the Plan Commission unanimously recommended approval of renaming Elmhurst Avenue, Dousman Street and Anamax Road to Duck Creek Parkway

BACKGROUND:
The 29/41 reconstruction has had a dramatic impact on the local roads in and around the 29/41 interchange. The project will cause some of the local roads to be "cut off" and will also cause the creation of new roads. The Village will need to consider the naming of the new roads that are being constructed, as well as the old roads that are no longer connected. Attached is a map of the area in which the majority of the impacts will be felt.

Staff would recommend renaming a portion of South Memorial Drive . The following suggestions were made by staff:

CHANGING THE NAME OF A PORTION OF SOUTH MEMORIAL DRIVE TO SCHICK
WAY

BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF HOWARD, RESOLVED:

1. That the names Elmhurst Avenue, Dousman Street and Anamax Road (as depicted on the attached map and described as follows) is hereby changed to Duck Creek Parkway.

Description:

Duck Creek Parkway (Dousman, Elmhurst, Anamax)

Part 1

All that part of existing Dousman St lying westerly of STH 41 as relocated under Transportation Project- 9202-07-23-4.07, lying northerly of STH 29-32 to CTH EB also known as Cardinal Lane, all lying within lots 296, 297, 298, 305, 306 and 308 of the Fort Howard Military Reserve.

Part 2

And also that part of the southerly extension of existing Dousman Street from its intersection with the northerly right of way of STH 29-32 under Transportation Project Plat- 9202-07-23-4.07 to the northerly right of way of Badgerland Dr. (Ulmer Ave) all located in Lots 305, 308 and 309 of the Fort Howard Military Reserve.

Part 3

And also that part of existing Elmhurst Ave and its northeasterly extension to the intersections of Cardinal Lane also known as CTH EB and existing Dousman Street , all located in Lot 298 of the Fort Howard Military Reserve, Village of Howard, Brown County, Wisconsin.



Please be informed the Village of Howard is proposing to change the names of streets in your neighborhood as follows:

Duck Creek Parkway (Dousman, Elmhurst, Anamax)

Part 1

All that part of existing Dousman St lying westerly of STH 41 as relocated under Transportation Project- 9202-07-23-4.07, lying northerly of STH 29-32 to CTH EB also known as Cardinal Lane, all lying within lots 296, 297, 298, 305, 306 and 308 of the Fort Howard Military Reserve.

Part 2

And also that part of the southerly extension of existing Dousman Street from its intersection with the northerly right of way of STH 29-32 under Transportation Project Plat-9202-07-23-4.07 to the northerly right of way of Badgerland Dr. (Ulmer Ave) all located in Lots 305, 308 and 309 of the Fort Howard Military Reserve.

Part 3

And also that part of existing Elmhurst Ave and its northeasterly extension to the intersections of Cardinal Lane also known as CTH EB and existing Dousman Street , all located in Lot 298 of the Fort Howard Military Reserve, Village of Howard, Brown County, Wisconsin.

A map of the project and proposed street renaming area is attached.

The proposed street name change is scheduled for review at the Village Board meeting 6:30 p.m. Monday, September 23, 2013 at Village Hall. The proposed change, if approved, will become effective immediately.
