Approve Resolution 2013- 25, renaming a portion of South Memorial Drive to Schick Way

RECOMMENDATION:
At its July meeting, the Plan unanimously recommended the renaming of a portion of South Memorial Drive to Schick Way.

BACKGROUND:
The 29/41 reconstruction has had a dramatic impact on the local roads in and around the 29/41 interchange. The project will cause some of the local roads to be “cut off” and will also cause the creation of new roads. The Village will need to consider the naming of the new roads that are being constructed, as well as the old roads that are no longer connected. Attached is a map of the area in which the majority of the impacts will be felt.

Staff would recommend renaming a portion of South Memorial Drive . The following suggestions were made by the owners (Schick family.) They are the only property that will have an address on the street.

- Off Season Place
- Alebree Way
- Renegade
- Touchdown Pass
- Schick Way
- I Can't Drive

The next step in the process is approval of a resolution by the Village Board and notification to affected property owners.


Suggestion #4 – Touchdown Pass – Again...going with my football background

CHANGING THE NAME OF A PORTION OF SOUTH MEMORIAL DRIVE TO SCHICK WAY

BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF HOWARD, RESOLVED:

1. That the name of South Memorial Drive (as depicted on the attached map and described as follows) is hereby changed to Schick Way.

Description:

All that part of S. Memorial Dr. being approximately 440' in length, lying immediately southwesterly of the Southerly right-of-way of the Wisconsin Central Limited Railroad and northerly of the northeasterly lines of Vol.36, CSM Pg.28, Map No.5464, Vol.32 CSM Pg.236, Map No.5007 and Vol.8 CSM Pg.325, Map No.1977 Brown County Records and between the westerly right-of-way of CTH EB, also known as Packerland Dr, and the extension of the southeasterly right of way of S. Memorial Dr. to said southwesterly line of the Wisconsin Central Limited Railroad. All located in Lot 303 of the Fort Howard Military Reserve, Village of Howard, Brown County, Wisconsin.

Right of Way Exhibit




Dear adjacent property owner:

Please be informed the Village of Howard is proposing to change the names of streets in your neighborhood as follows:

Portion of S. Memorial Drive to be renamed Schick Way

All that part of S. Memorial Dr. being approximately 440' in length, lying immediately southwesterly of the Southerly right-of-way of the Wisconsin Central Limited Railroad and northerly of the northeasterly lines of Vol.36, CSM Pg.28, Map No.5464, Vol.32 CSM Pg.236, Map No.5007 and Vol.8 CSM Pg.325, Map No.1977 Brown County Records and between the westerly right-of-way of CTH EB, also known as Packerland Dr, and the extension of the southeasterly right of way of S. Memorial Dr. to said southwesterly line of the Wisconsin Central Limited Railroad. All located in Lot 303 of the Fort Howard Military Reserve, Village of Howard, Brown County, Wisconsin.
