POLICY TITLE: Recognizing the Street Lights Policy for the Village of Howard,
Wisconsin

AUTHORIZATION: Village Board Resolution #2003-56

POLICY STATEMENT:

WHEREAS, the installation of street lights is necessary on public roads for the safety of pedestrians and motorists in the community; and

WHEREAS, the policy for installing street lights is to locate them at all intersections, curves, end of cul-de-sacs and on major collector streets; and

WHEREAS, the streetlights are installed shortly after a new subdivision is constructed; and

WHEREAS, too many street lights are not cost effective, are wasteful of valuable resources and become public nuisances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Board of the Village of Howard, Brown County, Wisconsin that the Village of Howard hereby authorizes the location of street lights only on public road intersections, curves, end of cul-de-sacs and on major collector streets.
