POLICY ISSUE

Should the Village Board modify the existing bond schedule for municipal court?

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Municipal Court Judge approached the Village Administrator earlier in the year believing the bond schedule used for municipal court should be updated. The Judge pointed out that municipal fines in both Green Bay and Suamico are substantially higher. The Judge believes that it is unwise for the Village to have forfeitures substantially lower than our two neighboring communities because it gives the impression that the Village is more tolerant of law violations. Also many defendants do arrive in court hoping for some reduction in their forfeitures, and if the bond schedule is changed to increase most fines, any reduction by the court still will result in an increased penalty.

Also, AB 22 was recently passed by the state legislature that if signed by the Governor will increase the allowable court cost collected by municipalities from \$28 to \$38. The proposed bond schedule makes that change. In the event the proposed bond schedule is approved for 2014 and the Governor vetoes the increase in court costs, the Administrator will return with a modified bond schedule. There may also need to be some changes made to the penalty section of the Village Code, and the Administrator will bring those to the Board at a future meeting.
