Dear Community Partner in Education:

Lineville Intermediate School, in partnership with the Village of Howard's Go Green-Save Green Task Force, is hosting its third annual Environmental Science Fair on Wednesday, May 1 at Lineville Intermediate School. We are looking for help in the following areas:

Science Fair Project Judging - There are about 20 student projects that have been entered for the scientific investigation category of the fair. This category is competitive; therefore, the projects that score in the top three will be awarded prizes. You will be working in judging teams of two people. Your task is to view students' displays and conduct an interview with them about their work. You will then use the evaluation tool to score the students' projects and issue an overall score. A copy of the "Judges Scorecard" accompanies this letter.

Interest Project Evaluator - There are about 4 students in this category who have chosen an environmental topic of interest and have learned more about it. Your main job is to give them a positive experience about learning something new! Your task as an evaluator would be to view the display, talk with the student(s) about what they learned, and offer them positive and/or constructive feedback on their performance by completing an evaluation form.

Judges and evaluators will need to arrive at Lineville Intermediate School by 8:00 am on Wednesday, May 1. We will have a brief meeting going over the process and evaluation forms to make sure all are comfortable with their tasks. Judging/Evaluating will begin at 9:00 am and run through about 12:00 pm, depending on the number of volunteers we have available for the day. The fair will be open to families and the community from 6:00-8:00 pm that evening.

If you are interested in helping out as a volunteer in one or both of the areas mentioned above, please contact me by **Wednesday, April 24**.
