**POLICY ISSUE**

Does the Village Board desire to change the official hunting map by removing one parcel that is currently under construction with a new subdivision?

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The parcel at the end of Copper Oak and Mighty Oak makes up the new addition to the Valley Brooke Subdivision and currently has approval for bow hunting. Since the parcel is under construction and will become a new subdivision in 2013, staff is proposing to remove it from the allowed bow hunting section of the official hunting map. The map attached to this report removes this parcel. Staff is looking for the village board to approve a motion that would adopt the new hunting map that excludes this one parcel. All other hunting locations remain the same as previously adopted by the village board in July 2011.




