We are in the business of “renewing” and “restoring” property. Whether it’s an insurance claim due to fire, water, or wind, or if the customer is remodeling, we will facilitate the project from beginning to end while using efficient and effective building practices.

We include these processes in our daily activities:

Prevent waste in the design phase by placing accurate orders

Buy building materials locally

Recycle or reuse materials from remodel and restoration projects, including doors and windows, fixtures, appliances, wood, wiring, etc. Save as much as possible from going to the landfill.

Use online banking and online bill pay for business expenses

Control thermostat in the shop to save on energy costs

Encourage customers to rebuild using green practices and high efficiency (recycling, HE appliances, recommendation of lighting, windows, doors and insulation, HVAC systems, etc)

Use local contractors and businesses to lower the impact of emissions generated by traveling to jobsites

Stay current on green construction practices

Filter/divert jobsite water runoff

Return unused items, instead of throwing them away

Avoid brands of products with excessive packaging

Use cleared brush and trees for mulch

Use empty paint and joint compound buckets for carrying materials or tools

Stop electric draw by unplugging all tools at the end of each day on the jobsite and at the shop

Keep spill kits on hand
