POLICY ISSUE

Should the Village Board approve the installation of security fencing at the Public Works Facility?

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Village Public Works Facility currently has a portion of its yard fenced to prevent unauthorized access to the storage areas (See attached map). It is proposed to fence the remaining open areas with the same style fencing currently in use. (See the attached photo).

Fencing quotes are as follows:
