

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-08

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF WISCONSIN'S VOTER ID LAW

WHEREAS, Wisconsin's Voter ID Law was fully enacted into law by the Wisconsin State Legislature and its governor in 2011; and

WHEREAS, the sanctity of our democratic voting process is protected by the Wisconsin Voter ID Law; and

WHEREAS, the requirements instituted by the Wisconsin Voter ID Law provide necessary protections against voter fraud; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Howard has spent numerous hours and resources over the last several months training village staff and poll workers for the Wisconsin State Voter ID Law; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Howard is fully prepared to implement the Wisconsin Voter ID requirements for the April 3, 2012 General Election; and

WHEREAS, the residents of Howard and Wisconsin deserve certainty in their voting requirements prior to the April 3, 2012 General Election; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Howard Board of Trustees recommends that the 2011 Voter ID Law be implemented for the April 3, 2012 General Election and beyond;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Board of Trustees in Howard, Wisconsin, does hereby publicly support Wisconsin's Voter ID Law with this resolution.
