POLICY ISSUE

Should the Village Board award the contract to MCC, Inc in the amount of \$442,787.89?

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The 2012 asphalt resurfacing project mainly consists of:

- Resurfacing a portion of Glendale Avenue (Spring Green to Oakhill, and Pawn to Hillcrest Heights)
- Resurfacing of a portion of Cornell Road (S. of Pamperin to Woodale)
- Resurfacing of a portion of Woodale Avenue (Jaymar to Rockwell)
- Resurfacing of Hazel Court

Project was budgeted for 2012, and the bids received came in under the budgeted amount.

*Village staff will perform portions of the site preparation work in advance of contracted asphalt paving and curbing.
