
BACKGROUND INFORMATION


Staff has given several updates regarding the Brown County Supervisory redistricting plan and the impact it will have on the Village of Howard's redistricting process. The Brown County Board again voted to increase the number of supervisors from 26 to 29, and once again County Executive Troy Streckenbach vetoed the plan. GIS Coordinator Tim Niemi has moved forward with a redistricting plan for Howard that is based off the ASSUMPTION of 26 supervisory districts. The board is cautioned that the number could change again.


We are providing you with three options for redistricting the Village of Howard's wards as a result of the 2010 census. Also attached is a map of the existing wards and their populations based on the 2010 census. We do believe that all of these scenarios keep current trustees in their wards, although that was not considered when the maps were prepared.
