POLICY ISSUE

Should the Village Board approve the utility relocation project?

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The work is a required utility relocation for the Highway 29/41 interchange project, per Trans. 220. The project has been designed, permitted, and bid. The utility relocation project is scheduled to take place from September 6, 2011 until late October, 2011.

PRIOR ACTION/REVIEW

The Village budgeted funds in 2011 for this work. A relocation estimate has been approved by WISDOT that will fund 90% of the relocation cost.

The total project budget including engineering and contingency is \$529,816.98.
