Fall is just around the corner, and league games will be starting soon. This year's league will be held at Nouryon Sports Complex, 1600 Pinecrest Road.

This year the **Fall Co-ed Slow Pitch league** will be played on **Tuesday** evenings. The team entry fee is **\$100**. Game times will be 6:00 pm and 7:00 pm.

The **registration deadline is Friday, August 21**. The league will need a minimum of 4 teams and has a **maximum of 8** teams. A Team Entry Form and full payment are due to reserve a spot in the league.

**Remember to register early, space is limited and teams will be accepted on a first come-first serve basis.**

Please note that this fall league will be a non-umpired league. Batting teams will be responsible for providing a home plate and field umpire.

League games will start Tuesday, September 8 and will go through October, depending on the number of teams in the league. Game times will be 6:00 and 7:00 pm. Schedules will be e-mailed to managers after September 4th.

Registration fees can be paid by check, cash or credit card in Village Hall (Monday-Thursday 7:30 am – 5:00 pm and Friday 7:30 – 11:30 am). Registrations with check/money order payments can also be mailed or dropped off in our after-hours drop box.
