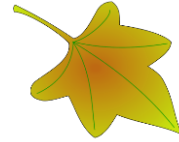

## 2018 Spring Leaf Collection

Residential Spring leaf and yard rakings collection will begin April 27, 2018 and run through approx. May 18, 2018. Leaves and yard rakings should be placed adjacent to the curb on the grass terrace. DO NOT place leaves in the street to prevent the clogging of storm drains. Bagged collections and green grass will not be collected. DO NOT comingle leaves & yard rakings with brush, branches, solid objects (like rootballs) pumpkins, corn stalks or sod that will damage or clog the vacuum collection equipment. DO NOT contaminate the piles with non-compostable or non-organic wastes.

## 2018 Brush Collection

In order to get your brush picked up, you must call (920)434-4060 no later than 1:00pm on Monday to get a Tuesday pickup.

Stack branches neatly between the sidewalk and the curb with cut ends facing or pointed toward the street. Brush piles that are badly tangled will not be picked up. Branches should NOT be tied with string, wire, or contain any other debris.

There is no length limit on branches but the largest diameter of branches is 6".

Brush from trees cut down by a professional tree service or other contractors are not to be placed at the curb & will not be picked up. These services are to dispose of their own brush.



## Grass & Other Yard Waste

Alternatively, residents may personally dispose of leaves, grass, sticks, branches, garden waste, corn stalks, bales of hay and other organic compostable wastes in the designated area at the Public Works Facility located at 1336 Cornell Road. Drop off at the Public Works Facility is available throughout the entire year. Brush and wood waste should be put in the designated area separated from other yard waste.
