POLICY STATEMENT:

Water Utility Rates

Rates are charged based on a per thousand gallon use. Since 2008, the water utilities are a monthly service charge rather than a quarterly charge. The Village Board’s last approval of the water utility rates were in 2004.

Sewer Utility Rates

All customers are charged \$2.89 per thousand gallons of water used. Also, the quarterly service charge is \$6.60 and a second meter charge (if used by customers) is \$3.00 per quarter. Industrial customers have additional charges for four components of sewage, as follows:

The sewer rates became effective September 1, 2003. The rates for the four components listed represent the anticipated change effective January 1 of each year listed and are matched the GBMSD's rates found in their budget document.

Storm Water Utility Rates

One ERU (equivalent residential unit) is equal to 3,301 square feet of impervious surface. Impervious surfaces are mainly constructed surfaces - driveways, sidewalks, roads, rooftops - that repel water and prevent precipitation.
